**Item No. 1                      First Charge on 2017 Capital Budget to Undertake Additional Local Street Renewal in 2016 MM #628-2016**

**STANDING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:**

On July 6, 2016, the Executive Policy Committee concurred in the recommendation of the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works and submitted the following to Council:

1.        That expenditures of up to \$8,000,000 be authorized in 2016 or prior to the adoption of the 2017 Capital Budget, as a first charge against the General Capital Fund, in accordance with Subsection 288(2) of the City of Winnipeg Charter, to allow extension of existing contracts to ensure timely delivery of local street renewals identified in Recommendation 2.
2.        That the local street projects listed in the Attachment be approved for the 2017 Regional and Local Street Renewal Program and commenced in 2016.

2. Report back to the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works at a meeting to be held before the Council meeting on July 13, 2016.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

1. That expenditures of up to \$8,000,000 be authorized in 2016 or prior to the adoption of the 2017 Capital Budget, as a first charge against the General Capital Fund, in accordance with Subsection 288(2) of the City of Winnipeg Charter, to allow extension of existing contracts to ensure timely delivery of local street renewals identified in Recommendation 2.

### REASON FOR THE REPORT

The Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works passed a motion at the June 28, 2016 meeting “*That the Director of Public Works be directed to provide a report listing local streets for rehabilitation from each of the 15 Wards, which will include all associated costs and that costing for these projects be identified as a first call on the 2017 Capital Budget and Report back to the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works at a meeting held before the Council meeting on July 13, 2016.*”

Council approval is required to make a first charge for an expenditure of capital funds prior to the adoption of the 2017 Capital Budget.

The approval of individual projects is required from the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works. The projects listed in the Attachment are to be funded by a first charge on the 2017 Capital Budget under the Regional and Local Street Renewal Program.

Council approval is required to delegate authority to the Chief Administrative Office to approve any over-expenditures arising from the extension of existing consulting engineering and construction contracts.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works passed a motion at the June 28, 2016 meeting directing the Administration to identify one additional local street in each Ward that can be moved forward from the 2017 Regional and Local Street Renewal Program to commence Work in 2016.

The Attachment provides a list of one street from each Ward that is recommended to proceed in 2016. These streets have been identified to be undertaken under the Regional and Local Street Renewal Program in 2017 and require a first charge of \$8,000,000 on the 2017 Capital Budget.

In order to attempt to complete these additional local street renewal works in 2016 at this stage of the 2016 construction season, existing consulting engineering and construction contracts will need to have their scope extended. None of these works will be tendered.

As no pre-engineering has been performed it may not be possible to start and complete all construction of the full list of local street renewals identified.

## **IMPLICATIONS OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS**

The additional 2017 local street renewal works undertaken in 2016 will reduce the amount of tendered work in 2017 under the Regional and Local Street Renewal Program.

## **HISTORY / DISCUSSION**

The following were taken into consideration in developing the list of recommended locations for renewal:

- The most recent ratings from the Pavement Condition Rating system were used.
- The locations are programmed by need across the entire City.
- The locations and treatments are such that the engineering work required is small so that construction could begin quickly.
- Only street rehabilitations are considered as this treatment has highest likelihood that it can be completed in the 2016 construction season.
