## CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**RE: THATCHER DRIVE FROM PEMBINA HIGHWAY TO UNIVERSITY CRESCENT**

We wish to advise you that the above street renewal project was approved for construction in Summer 2019, however was delayed due to poor weather conditions in the fall of 2019.

**Construction is expected to begin May 11, 2020 weather permitting and shall take five weeks to complete.**

We will be repairing the concrete pavement and renewing the curb followed by the placement of a new asphalt overlay to improve the drainage and rideability. During construction, the street will be restricted to local access only and parking on the street shall be prohibited. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Access to driveways shall be maintained during the majority of construction works.

We welcome questions, as well as ask those with accessibility needs, moving requirements, planned special events or known underground appurtenances (such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc.) within 20 feet of the curb, to contact me at (204)928-8431.

We apologize for the inconvenience and disruption construction will cause and appreciate your patience as we work to make your street better.
