CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Residents and Business Owners on Braeside PI between Point West Dr to End
RE: 2020 Thin Bituminous Overlay Program

Please be advised the above Thin Bituminous Overlay (TBO) is scheduled to begin this spring/summer.

Construction start: Week of May 17, 2021, weather permitting
Duration: Approximately three (3) Weeks, weather permitting
Traffic implications:

- Restricted on-street parking
- Reduction to one lane for local-access vehicular traffic

As part of this work, we will adjust catch basins and manholes, repair concrete pavement, replace missing and damaged curbs, repair sidewalks as needed, restore the boulevard, mill the existing asphalt overlay and install a new asphalt overlay.

During construction, on-street parking will be prohibited and one lane of two-way local-access traffic will be maintained. During some portions of the work, the street will be completely closed to traffic and private approaches will not be accessible. In these situations, you will be notified at least 24 hours prior to the disruption of access.

Transit service will be maintained throughout construction, though temporary bus stop relocations or closures may be required at various times.

Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times. The contractor may relocate bins if required.
