CITY CENTRE COMMUNITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

On March 25, 2022, City Centre Community Committee recommended to the Governance Committee of Council:

1. That the following amendments be considered for incorporation in the final report to Council on the City of Winnipeg Governance Review:
 - A. Section 5.1:
 - i. Amend Recommendation 1 to “Develop a formal orientation process, and diverse orientation products, that include documented Roles and Responsibilities for Members of Council, and their political staff.”
 - ii. As part of Recommendation 3, add additional direction to the Public Service to report back on options for additional full-time public service staff dedicated to supporting political office, both Council and Mayor’s Office.
 - B. Section 5.3:
 - i. As part of Recommendation 5, add additional direction to the Public Service to provide a formal interpretation of section 62.1 of the City of Winnipeg Charter for Council’s consideration.
 - ii. As part of Recommendations 7 and 15, do not eliminate the role of Community Committee, but clarify the role of the committee and look at streamlining the process.
 - iii. As part of Recommendation 8, add additional direction to the Public Service to report back on options for additional full-time public service staff (IRD) dedicated to providing advice to Council as a whole
 - C. Section 5.4:
 - i. As part of Recommendations 10 and 12, add the following additional recommendations:
 - a. That funding required to update DMIS be referred to the Budget Process
 - b. That the Public Service report back on making the Open Data portal more accessible

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CITY CENTRE COMMUNITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION (continued):

- c. That the Public Service be directed to do a Lean Management process with Council (this process could be replicated with these external groups to look at ways to make Council decision-making and public engagement processes more transparent and accessible)
- ii. As part of Recommendation 11, add additional direction to the public service to research best practices in other cities and report back with the implications in the City of Winnipeg
- iii. As part of Recommendation 14, add additional direction to the public service to:
 - a. Provide an update on the framework of monitoring progress, reviewing priorities and renewing the plan
 - b. Refer the creation of two-day workshops (to occur three times per year) on the four-year strategic plan for all of Council to the budget review process.
 - c. Create quantitative and qualitative benchmarks tied to the four-year budget cycle
