**Item No. 7                      Transit Routes to Service the Prairie Pointe Neighbourhood  
(Waverley West Ward)**

Councillor Lukes, Waverley West Ward, has submitted the following motion to the Assiniboia Community Committee for consideration:

WHEREAS the Waverley West Ward has seen the largest population increase of all wards in the City of Winnipeg, with a population increase of 25% over since the last census;

AND WHEREAS the bulk of new development has occurred in the neighborhoods of Bridgwater Trails and Prairie Pointe since the last census;

AND WHEREAS the junior and high schools are overcrowded, with students having to transport themselves to schools east of Pembina Highway;

AND WHEREAS according to Winnipeg Transit staff, routes 671 and 672 are experiencing high passenger loads, despite operating 60-foot articulated buses on select trips, which is unprecedented on feeder routes in Winnipeg;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Standing Policy Committee on Public Works be required to direct the Winnipeg Public Service to review and report back in 120 days with proposed new transit routes, and associated costs, to better serve the Prairie Pointe neighbourhood.
